Joseph and Matt, co-founders of ZeroKey said "We were delighted to come away with the 'Best in Show' prize. Deciding to develop a brand-new piece of technology and then introduce this publicly comes with its own risks and a degree of trepidation – especially after only 6 months. So, to receive external validation in a very public forum from both the expert panel and via the audience vote was incredibly rewarding."

The prize is to take the stage at one of the lang cat's major events later this year, giving ZeroKey further exposure to potential investors and customers.
